WHEREAS, AHMOPI has signed a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the PHILIPPINE PEDIATRIC SOCIETY, a private corporation duly registered and existing in accordance with the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with office address at # 52 Kalayaan Avenue, Barangay Malaya, Diliman, Quezon City, hereinafter referred to as "PPS".

WHEREAS, the PPS-AHMOPI MOA is effective January 1, 2021 and shall expire on December 31, 2023, after which both parties may jointly review, revise and/or modify the said MOA, if necessary, prior to its renewal for another three (3)-year term.

WHEREAS, AHMOPI Members are desirous of entering arrangement with Pediatricians in different localities/communities all over the Philippines for the purpose of providing medical services to its members:

WHEREAS, the Pediatrician is duly licensed to practice medicine in the Philippines, and has signed his/her conformity to the provisions of the MOA between the PPS and the AHMOPI.

WHEREAS, the provisions of the MOA its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) shall cover all Pediatricians of the Philippine Pediatric Society who are willing to be part hereof; and all members of AHMOPI, provided they signify their consent hereto in writing with their respective parties.

- Pediatricians appearing in the roll of memberships of good standing who voluntarily consent to join to the MOA are covered. Pediatricians who have consented to join the MOA can be chosen by AHMOPI patients.
- 2. Pediatricians who voluntarily consent to the MOA cannot refuse AHMOPI patients once they are chosen, except for just cause as provided for by the Philippine Medical Jurisprudence.
- AHMOPI members who have consented to the MOA cannot refuse the Pediatricians who have agreed to join the same, except for just cause/s as determined by the PPS-AHMOPI Liaison Committee.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises the parties hereby mutually agree as follows:

1. The following Professional Fees (PF) in Philippine Peso, and exclusive of Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PHIC/PhilHealth) fees, will be paid. The PF schedules may be revised and/or modified every two years by the Parties beginning 01 January 2023 and implemented the same way in the renewal years.

1.1. Outpatient Consultation Fees

The outpatient consultation fees of the **Pediatrician** shall be five hundred pesos (**PhP 500.00**).

1.2. Inpatient Daily Visits

All PF's for both attending **Pediatrician** and co-managing **Pediatrician** shall be based on the following payment schemes:

- Ward PhP 750.00
 Semi-Private PhP 950.00
 Private PhP 1,050.00
 Suite PhP 1,400.00
 ICU/CCU PhP 1,600.00
- 1.3. Other fees, exclusive of PHIC/PhilHealth) fees, are as follows:
 - 1.3.1. For routine pre-procedure medical evaluation, inpatient and outpatient, without medical indications PhP 1,000.00.
 - 1.3.2. For pre-procedure medical evaluation, inpatient and outpatient, with medical indications PhP 1,200.00.
 - 1.3.3. Inpatient medical evaluation, intra-operative monitoring PhP 1,600.00.

1.4. Room Upgrade

- 1.4.1. Incremental costs, if any, of <u>involuntary room</u> <u>upgrades</u> (i.e., from one room category to the next higher room category, e.g., from ward to semi-private, semi-private to private, private to suite; not from "small" to "large" room of the same category) will be shouldered by the AHMOPI-Member concerned based on their respective contracts with their members.
- 1.4.2. Incremental costs, if any, of <u>voluntary room upgrades</u> (i.e., from one room category to the next higher room category, e.g., from ward to semi-private, semi-private to private, private to suite; not from "small" to "large" room

of the same category) will be shouldered by the memberpatients. For voluntary room upgrades as defined above, the Pediatrician may bill AHMOPI patients for the difference in professional fees (PFs) between the member-patient's original room category upgraded room used, based on the PF schedules of the AHMOPI-Member concerned. The same PF schedules of Items 1.1, 1.2, & 1.3 above should likewise be used for AHMOPI patients who exceed their Maximum Benefit Limit (MBL) or Aggregate Benefit Limit (ABL) under their respective Agreements.

The Pediatrician shall not "balance-bill" AHMOPI patients for coverable health conditions and availments. However, for non-coverable health conditions and availments, the Pediatrician should bill AHMOPI patients for PFs based on the PF schedules of the AHMOPI-Member concerned.

All PFs are subject to the prevailing withholding tax rates and such other tax provisions. The prevailing Value Added Tax (VAT) currently at 12% shall be shouldered by the AHMOPI-Member provided the Pediatrician submits VAT a registration certificate to the AHMOPI Member. On the other hand, withholding tax will be deducted from the Physician's PFs,

For medical procedures listed in the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation and Philippine College of Surgeons (PCS) handbook of 2001, as amended in 01 April 2009, AHMOPI Members agree to pay PFs based on the 2009 PHIC Relative Value Scale (RVS) and the Philippine College of Surgeons-AHMOPI MOA.

For those procedures not listed, the PPS-AHMOPI Liaison Committee, in collaboration with the PPS Subspecialties concerned, shall meet and decide on the most appropriate PF schedules.

Il bills presented by the Pediatrician with complete documentation shall be fully paid by the AHMOPI Member according to the negotiated rates within forty-five (45) days from receipt of outpatient claims from the Physician; and within sixty (60) days from receipt of inpatient claims from the hospital.

- 6.1. A penalty of 3% per month shall be imposed on delays from submission of outpatient and inpatient claims (using the same 45-day and 60-day turn-around time after providing services to the patient) to payment of claims.
- 6.2. It is the responsibility of the AHMOPI-Member to remit the payments for PFs directly to the Pediatrician, including the certificate of tax
