	05.	Marriage contract or any relevant supporting document if the applicant has changed names or has not been submitted during the application for the written exam (certified true copy)
	06.	Certification from the PPS of passing the written examination within the last 2 years (submit a scanned copy)
	07.	Three (3) letters of recommendation <u>attesting to his / her good moral and professional conduct.</u> The letters should be <u>written by the recommending Fellows and not the applicant.</u>
		a. Department Chair
		b. Two (2) Fellows in good standing
	08.	Letter from the Section Head is the applicant is currently on subspecialty training
	09.	Certificates of attendance with CPD units, at least twenty-five (25) units per year from PPS-accredited conferences, if the examination will be taken more than one (1) year after graduation from residency (<u>scanned</u> copies of certificates arranged chronologically; if photocopies are submitted, the applicant must present the original certificates)
		If a previous application has been denied due to lack of CPD units, the applicant must submit certificates of attendance with at least twenty-five (25) units per year from PPS-accredited conferences AND sixty (60) units per year from the PPS Convention.
		If the interval between two (2) examinations is < six (6) months, no CPD unit is required.
	10.	Certificate of attendance to a review course for applicants who failed the written exams thrice.
	11.	Non-refundable examination fee upon submission of the application
	12.	Written explanation for any deficiency in the requirements (if applicable)
